The Department of Pediatrics at the University of Illinois College of Medicine is pleased to announce an intensive, two-day evidence-based medicine (EBM) workshop for clinical directors and instructors of student and resident medical education.

Evidence-based medicine is a complementary approach to clinical practice that applies the principles of clinical epidemiology to the traditional skills of patient care. This workshop includes short lectures, hands-on activities, an actual EBM presentation at morning report, and opportunities to practice EBM teaching skills and discuss development of EBM training programs.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of the activity, participants should be able to:

1. Develop formal clinical questions based on patient encounters
2. Conduct a literature search using PubMed Clinical Queries and Ovid (including Cochrane Collaboration)
3. Critically appraise the methodological validity of a clinical study
4. Interpret study results using statistical summaries and online EBM tools, and apply these to hypothetical cases
5. Explain the EBM process to their students

AUDIENCE

This workshop is aimed at physicians and dentists actively involved in the education of students and residents. Previous workshops, held in Chicago, San

Francisco, and Guatemala City, have included clinicians in the fields of internal medicine, pediatrics, surgery, ENT, family practice, intensive care, dentistry, and infectious disease.

Jordan Hupert, MD, is Assistant Professor of Clinical Pediatrics, Student Clerkship Director, and Associate Residency Program Director in the Department of Pediatrics. **Jerry Niederman, MD, MPH**, is Associate Professor of Clinical Pediatrics and head of the Division of General Pediatrics. **Alan Schwartz, PhD**, is Assistant Professor of Clinical Decision Making in the Department of Medical Education and Adjunct Professor in the Department of Pediatrics. **Monte Hetland, MD** is Assistant Professor of Clinical Pediatrics. **Lilly Immergluck, MD** is Assistant Professor of Pediatrics. All faculty are actively involved in the education of medical students and residents and are partners in a number of EBM educational and research projects.

MATERIALS AND PREPARATION

Prior to the workshop, preparatory materials will be sent to participants. In order for each participant to get the most out of this intensive workshop, some advance preparation will be necessary.

The workshop will be held at The University of Illinois at Chicago Medical Center. Specific details will be sent to registrants by e-mail. Travel and accommodation arrangements are the responsibility of the participant. Our office will be happy to help with suggestions for nearby accommodations.
