The Department of Pediatrics at the University of Illinois at Chicago is pleased to announce an updated two-day evidence-based medicine (EBM) workshop for physicians *of any medical discipline* who are involved in medical education. This workshop, limited to ~20 participants, includes short lectures and hands-on activities. Familiarity with the basic principles of EBM is recommended.

Topics include: Question generation, searching tips, primary/meta-analytic/non-inferiority therapy studies, diagnostic test studies, the “R(a)PID” appraisal technique, issues of patient application, teaching strategies and learning programs, online tools

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of the activity, participants should be able to:

1. Develop formal clinical questions based on patient encounters
2. Conduct an efficient clinical literature search
3. Critically appraise the methodological validity and analyze the results of clinical studies using appraisal summaries and online EBM tools
4. Demonstrate “R(a)PID,” a technique for quick, efficient critical-appraisal
5. Explain the EBM process to their learners
6. Identify criteria for evidence application at the bedside
